Our focus is to provide quality, individualized services to those who are affected by substance use or problem gambling related issues. Addiction Counselors will work with you to decide which combination of services will best meet your individual needs. Individual, group & family counseling, Screening & assessments, Referrals for detox and treatment programs, Codependency/family, Gambling services, Prevention, education & community development, Youth & family services, Dual disorders, Community Support Program (transition housing).

Adult Services

Services are available to individuals 18 years of age and over who may be experiencing emotional difficulties, problems with living and/or psychiatric disorders. The goal of services is to enhance the ability of the individual to interact effectively with their environment, enrich their day to day functioning and quality of life by improving their capacity to manage day to day issues. Services are individualized to the client need. The Adult Community Services Team provides: Therapy for adults who are experiencing stress, anxiety, grief, depression or struggling with thoughts of harming themselves, therapy/support for individuals who are having difficulty coping with their day to day life, Psychological testing to assist in the diagnosis and treatment planning of mental disorders and Consultation and referrals to the appropriate service agents as required.
